

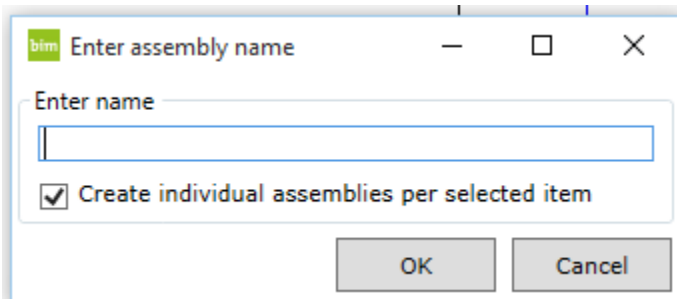
Assembly sheet(s)



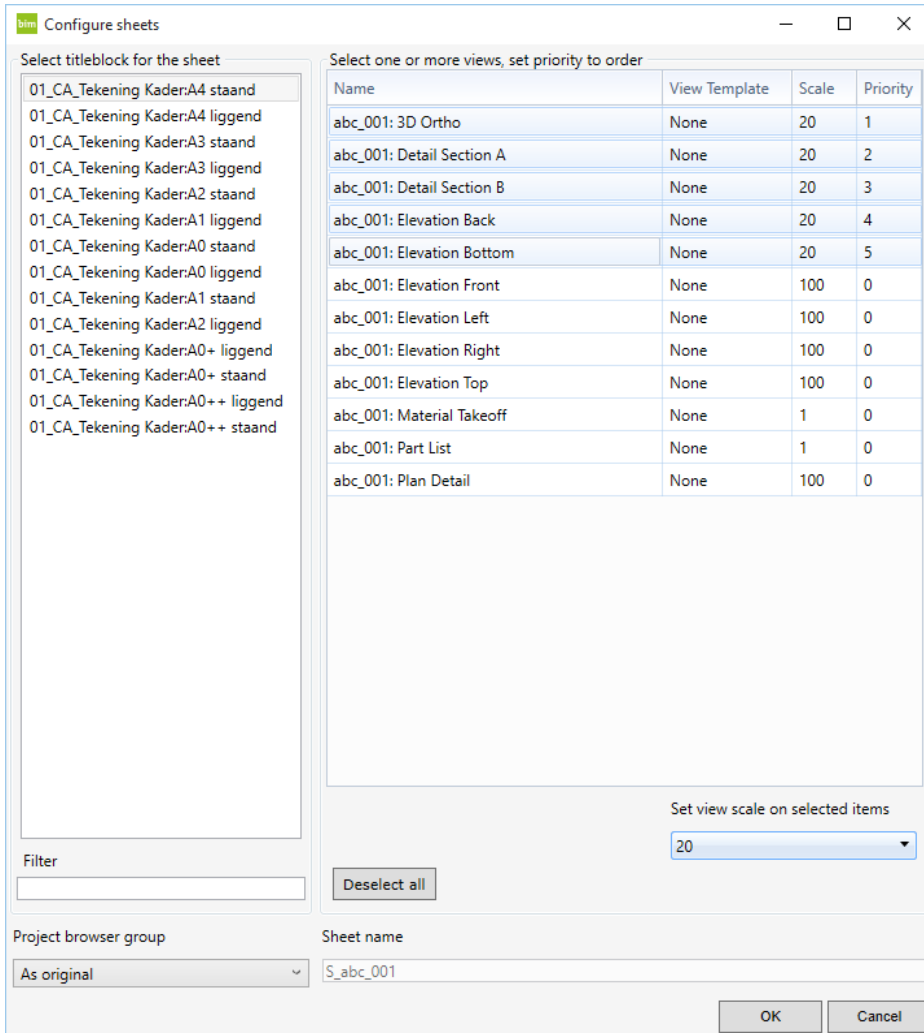
Creating assemblies is a powerful feature of Revit, however, when you need to create a lot of them, you would like to have a shortcut.

This plugin allows us to create one or multiple assemblies, automatically create the related views and automatically create the sheets where the assemblies will be placed upon.

- Preselect the items you wanted to be added to the assembly to be created. The first item of the selection determines the assembly category
- Start 'Assemblies' from the ribbon
- Enter assembly name and choose if you want to create individual assemblies for every selected item, or one assembly with all the selected items within it



- After that the assembly views will be created and the following dialogue appears. This is the same dialogue as in the sheet configurator. You can select a titleblock and the views in the order you want them to be placed on the assembly sheet, but you can also adjust the view scale of the views by selecting a different scale from the dropdown list. This has an effect on the items that are selected in the grid.



- The assembly sheet(s) will be created and set as the active view
